With reference to the captioned subject, we would like to inform you that the Company has received an Order from Deputy Commissioner, Haridwar, Uttarakhand imposing a penalty of Rs. 1,57,58,256.97/- with respect to GST assessment for the FY 2020-2021 under applicable provisions of the Uttarakhand GST Act 2017, CGST Act 2017 and IGST Act 2017 in relation to alleged excess Input Tax Credit claimed by the Company for the stated period.

Based on the Company's assessment, prevailing law and basis the advice of the counsel, the Company is hopeful of a favourable outcome at the next adjudicating authority/ tribunal level and does not reasonably expect the said Order to have any material financial impact on the Company.

The Order dated 11 March 2026 was received on the same day by the Company at 5:00 p.m. (IST).
