PRESS RELEASE**FINANCIAL RESULTS FOR THE QUARTER AND YEAR ENDED MARCH 31, 2026**

A meeting of the Board of Directors of HDB Financial Services Limited was held in Mumbai on Wednesday, April 15, 2026 to consider and approve the audited financial results for the quarter and year ended 31st March 2026.

Performance Highlights – Q4FY26:

- Net interest income was ₹ 2,399 crore for the quarter ended March 31, 2026 compared to ₹ 1,973 crore for the quarter ended March 31, 2025, an increase of 21.6%
- Net total income was ₹ 3,063 crore for the quarter ended March 31, 2026 compared to ₹ 2,616 crore for the quarter ended March 31, 2025, an increase of 17.1%
- Pre-provisioning operating profit was ₹ 1,696 crore for the quarter ended March 31, 2026 compared to ₹ 1,338 crore for the quarter ended March 31, 2025, an increase of 26.7%
- Loan losses and provisions was ₹ 685 crore for the quarter ended March 31, 2026 compared to ₹ 634 crore for the quarter ended March 31, 2025, an increase of 8.0%
- Profit before tax was ₹ 1,011 crore for the quarter ended March 31, 2026 compared to ₹ 704 crore for the quarter ended March 31, 2025, an increase of 43.6%
- Profit after tax was ₹ 751 crore for the quarter ended March 31, 2026 compared to ₹ 531 crore for the quarter ended March 31, 2025, an increase of 41.4%
- Profit after tax was ₹ 2,544 crore for the year ended March 31, 2026 compared to ₹ 2,176 crore for the year ended March 31, 2025, an increase of 16.9%
- Asset under management (AUM) was ₹ 1,18,733 crore as on March 31, 2026 compared to ₹ 1,07,262 crore as on March 31, 2025, a growth of 10.7%
- Gross Loan Book stood at ₹ 1,18,493 crore as on March 31, 2026 compared to ₹ 1,06,878 crore as on March 31, 2025, a growth of 10.9%
- Gross Stage 3 loans was at 2.44% as against 2.26% as at March 31, 2025
- Net Stage 3 loans was at 1.09% as against 0.99% as at March 31, 2025
- Provision Coverage stood at 55.53% on stage 3 assets as against 55.95% as at March 31, 2025
