Herbal alternative to morning caffeine? try Patanjali Divya Herbal Drink

automated laboratory costing Rs. 25 crore has been approved for Hamirpur Medical College as part of efforts to strengthen diagnostic services. In the coming years, a Super Specialty Block and a Dental College will also be established at the institution. Additionally, the facility will soon introduce robotic surgery services, marking

a significant step towards advanced medical care in the region. The Chief Minister assured that all modern medical equipment would be installed and made operational before shifting to the new building. Several public representatives, senior doctors and other district officers and officials were present on the occasion.
