## CM Rekha flags off 200 e-buses, launches Delhi-Rohtak service

New Delhi

Delhi Chief Minister Rekha Gupta on Friday flagged off 200 new electric buses, pushing the city's total fleet beyond 6,300 and strengthening its position as the largest electric bus network in the country.

The Government also launched an interstate electric bus service between Delhi and Rohtak and inaugurated key transport infrastructure projects.

The Chief Minister said the move is part of a broader plan to make Delhi cleaner and reduce pollution through electric mobility. She added that improving connectivity and modernising public transport remain central to the government's agenda.

The event was held at the East Vinod Nagar depot in the presence of Transport Minister Dr Pankaj Kumar Singh and senior officials. Along with the induction of new buses, the Government opened a new bus terminal at Madanpur Khadar and inaugurated an administrative building at the depot.

The Chief Minister said the government aims to provide better transport access, cleaner air, and efficient services for commuters. She noted that several of the newly inducted buses are designed to operate in narrow lanes and under-served areas, improving last-mile connectivity.

She also highlighted that the Delhi Government is working under a long-term plan to expand and modernise the transport system.

A budget of ₹4,000 crore has been allocated over four years to promote electric vehicles. The plan includes incentives such as road tax

exemptions and a phased transition of school and commercial vehicles to electric mode.

Transport Minister Dr

Pankaj Kumar Singh said the day marked a major step forward for Delhi's transport system. He said the addition of new buses, expansion of

interstate routes, and development of infrastructure reflect the government's focus on safe, accessible, and modern public transport.

He added that the department is working to make the system more efficient and commuter-friendly.

According to him, the Delhi Transport Corporation has also recorded an increase in revenue over the past year, indicating improved performance. With the latest addition, Delhi's bus fleet now includes over 4,500 electric buses along with CNG buses.

The Government plans to expand the total fleet to around 14,000 buses by 2028-29.

The new electric buses are equipped with safety and passenger-friendly features such as CCTV cameras, panic buttons, and real-time track-

ing systems. Facilities for persons with disabilities have also been included.

The newly launched Delhi-Rohtak electric bus service will operate via key routes, including ISBT Kashmere Gate and Peeragarhi, connecting areas such as Tikri Border, Bahadurgarh, and Sampla before reaching Rohtak. Officials said the service will improve regional connectivity and reduce dependence on conventional fuel-based transport.

The Madanpur Khadar bus terminal, located near Kalindi Kunj Metro Station, has been developed with basic passenger amenities.

It includes bus bays, shelters, parking spaces, and accessible infrastructure such as ramps. Around 22 buses are expected to operate from this terminal

on multiple routes.

The administrative building at East Vinod Nagar depot has been designed to improve working conditions for staff. It includes office space, rest areas, a canteen, and health check facilities for drivers. Safety features such as a fire system and water conservation measures have also been installed.

The Chief Minister also announced plans to set up an electric vehicle waste disposal plant in Holambi Kalan to manage battery disposal in an environmentally safe manner. The chief minister said that a massive 'EV Waste Disposal Plant' will be established in the Holambi Kalan area to ensure the scientific disposal of electric vehicle batteries in the future, thereby safeguarding the environment.

## DERC proposes to amend open access green energy regulations

In a move that will promote cleaner renewable energy consumption by commercial users in the national Capital, the Delhi Electricity Regulatory Commission (DERC) has proposed to amend the open access green energy regulations.

Green Energy Open Access (GEOA) is a regulatory framework through which consumers with a connected load of 100 kW and more can directly purchase renewable energy from the suppliers, excluding local discoms, and thereby save up to 30-40 per cent of their electricity bills.

Under the existing Delhi Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Green Energy Open Access) Regulations, 2024, the eligibility for availing GEOA is restricted to consumers connected at 11 kV and above and having a sanctioned load of 100 kW



and above.

"The said voltage-based restriction had the effect of excluding consumers who meet the prescribed load criterion but are connected at voltage levels below 11 kV from availing the Green Energy Open Access benefit," said a Delhi Electricity Regulatory Commission (DERC) document.

This is contrary to the GEOA framework's objective to promote a uniform, technology-neutral and load-based eligibility regime, enabling access to renewable energy across consumer categories, the officials said.

The DERC has now issued a draft Delhi Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Green Energy Open Access) (First Amendment) Regulations, 2026 document seeking feedback from stakeholders over the proposed reduction in the voltage criterion from the current 11 kV to less than 11 kV.

The issue of GEOA applicability to consumers connected below 11 kV has emerged, especially in the case of those in telecom sectors, commercial infrastructures and medium, small and micro enterprises (MSMEs) that are characterised by geographically dispersed loads and predominantly low tension (LT) connectivity.

The issue was also discussed in meetings of the Delhi government's power department in which the need to enable wider access to GEOA was stressed, the officials said.

## Metro services on Blue Line to be regulated on Sunday morning for maintenance

Metro services on the Blue Line of the Delhi Metro will be briefly regulated on Sunday morning to facilitate scheduled track maintenance work between Indraprastha and Supreme Court stations, the DMRC said on Friday.

According to the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation, the regulation will be in place during the early morning hours on April 19, affecting train operations on Line 3 and Line 4. As per the revised schedule, the first train from Vaishali towards Dwarka Sector-21 will depart at 6.05 am, while services from Laxmi Nagar towards Dwarka Sector-21 will begin at 6.21 am.

The first train from Yamuna Bank towards Dwarka Sector-21 will start at 5.50 am, it said.

## DTC records 21% rise in income to ₹995 crore in 2025-26: Minister

The Delhi Transport Corporation (DTC) has recorded about a 21 per cent rise in its income to ₹995.55 crore in 2025-26, Transport Minister Pankaj Singh said on Friday.

As per the latest financial data, DTC's total income has increased from ₹822.53 crore in 2024-25 to ₹995.55 crore in 2025-26 (up to March 26), registering a growth of approximately ₹173 crore.

"This turnaround is the result of the collective effort, commitment and dedication of the entire DTC family. The previous government had left DTC in a financially weakened state, burdened with losses," the transport minister said.

In contrast, the present government has taken decisive steps to revive the corporation, streamline operations, and transform it



into a more financially stable and accountable public transport entity, he added.

As per the data, ticketed income has increased from ₹327.23 crore to ₹379.77 crore, registering a growth of ₹52.54 crore on a year-on-year basis, while earnings from special hire services have risen from ₹82.65 crore to ₹99.21 crore, marking an increase of ₹16.56 crore during the same period.

"The most significant growth has been recorded under miscellaneous income, which has increased from ₹342.67 crore to ₹446.59 crore,

reflecting a substantial rise of ₹103.92 crore, till March 2026," an official said.

This category includes revenue from advertisements, rent receipts and penalty collections.

"The corporation has also recorded an increase in average monthly income from ₹68.54 crore to ₹82.96 crore, indicating stronger financial discipline and better resource utilisation," the minister added.

He added that the Government's approach goes beyond increasing revenue; it focuses on strengthening institutional capacity.

## RD schools achieve 100% pass rate in CBSE Class 10
