The appeal for AY 2022-23 is still pending before Commissioner of Income Tax (Appeal).</p> <p>The total outstanding demand for AY 2018-19 AY 2021-22 and AY 2023-24 to 2024-25 was Rs 12.25 crores. In opinion of the management, the said demand of Rs 12.25 crores will reduce to Rs 2.45 crores after appeal effect order is passed by the assessing officer in line with the orders of the Commissioner of Income Tax (Appeals).</p> <p>The Company will file appeals before the Income Tax Appellate Tribunal against balance demand of Rs 2.45 crores.</p>
