100 airports in 10 years

India will build 100 new airports over the next 10 years as part of an ambitious expansion of regional air connectivity, Civil Aviation Minister K. Ram Mohan Naidu has said, underlining the Government's plans to make air travel accessible to more people and bring aviation infrastructure closer to smaller cities and towns.

The proposed expansion will be carried out under the modified UDAN regional connectivity scheme, which has been approved for implementation from 2026-27 to 2035-36. The programme has a total Government outlay of Rs. 28,840 crore, with the wider initiative aimed at strengthening connectivity in underserved and unserved regions.

Naidu said India's aviation sector had undergone remarkable expansion in recent years. The number of airports in the country has increased from 74 in 2014 to 166 now, reflecting the rapid growth of aviation infrastructure and rising demand for air travel.

The next phase, he said, would take this expansion further by developing 100 additional airports over the coming decade. The Minister made the remarks while inaugurating India's third hub-and-

Self reliance

The modified UDAN programme is also expected to support the wider Atmanirbhar Bharat (self reliance) initiative by strengthening the indigenous aviation ecosystem, including aircraft manufacturing, maintenance and related services. With passenger traffic continuing to grow and demand spreading beyond the country's major metropolitan centres, the proposed construction of 100 new airports represents one of India's biggest aviation infrastructure expansion plans. The success of the initiative, however, will depend not only on building airports but also on ensuring sustainable airline operations, adequate last-mile connectivity and affordable fares for passengers.

The expansion is expected to focus particularly on improving air connectivity for Tier-2 and Tier-3 cities and regions that have remained outside the mainstream aviation network. The modified UDAN scheme also envisages the development of modern helipads and support for a large number of regional aerodromes.

The Government's objective is not merely to construct new airport facilities but to create a more sustainable regional aviation ecosystem. The scheme provides for financial support to improve the viability of regional routes and airports, while encouraging airlines

to expand services to destinations where commercial operations may otherwise be difficult.

The move could provide a significant boost to tourism, trade and investment in smaller cities. Better air links are also expected to improve access to healthcare and emergency services in remote and hilly regions, where road connectivity can often be challenging.

Naidu said the growing aspirations of the people were driving the rapid expansion of civil aviation. For many towns, the demand is no longer limited to better roads or railway connections, but increasingly includes access to an airport and regular air services.

CBCID files case on deepfake video impersonating CM

Chennai, Sep 3: The Cyber Crime Cell of the Tamil Nadu Crime Branch CID (CBCID) has registered a case after detecting AI-generated deepfake videos impersonating Chief Minister C. Jeyaraj and directing people to contact WhatsApp numbers for purported financial assistance.

The scam videos, including one with Hindi audio, were found circulating on Facebook and other social media platforms during routine cyber patrolling. Police said the content was created to deceive people by falsely portraying the chief minister as offering financial help.

A special report on the suspicious video was submitted on September 1, following which the CBCID Cyber Crime Cell registered a case the same day and launched an investigation.

CBCID has sought details from Meta about the Facebook account that circulated the video, including relevant logs, and has also initiated steps to have the content

removed. Preliminary investigation revealed that several similar AI-generated videos impersonating the chief minister were being circulated across multiple social media platforms. Police said many of the videos appeared to have been shared through Facebook accounts purportedly based in

Pakistan. Investigators are working to identify those behind the videos and trace their origin and circulation network.

Tamil Nadu Police cautioned people against responding to phone numbers displayed in such videos or joining WhatsApp groups promoted through them.

Retd Air Marshal Mishra to head Ram temple trust

Ayodhya, Sep 3: Air Marshal (retd) Jhendra Mishra, who led Operation Sindoor, was nominated as the first Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Shri Ram Janmabhoomi Trust (SRJT) on Wednesday.

This decision was made unanimously at a trust meeting chaired by Mahant Nitya Gopal Das at the Akash Ram Das Chhatra in Ayodhya. Key Trust officials and invited members were present at the meeting, while some attended virtually. The appointment of CEO and change in the trust was made after offering theft was detected from the Ram temple in the last week of June leading to resignation of General Secretary Champa Rai and Trustee Anil Mishra.

Besides the new CEO, Govind Dev Giri will be the new General Secretary of the trust. Three new members of the trust were also announced at the meeting. The new members include Mahant Mohan Das, Ayodhya, Mahesh Bhagchandani from Delhi, and Nimisha Yadav from Shikohabad. Mahesh Bhagchandani will be the new Treasurer of the trust.

Board revamp fallout of offering theft

Bhatpur Rani area of Deoria district, was commissioned as a fighter pilot in the Indian Air Force on December 6, 1986. During his long military career, he flew more than 18 types of aircraft and accumulated over 3,000 hours of flying experience.

Air Marshal (retd) Mishra will take charge soon. The board of trustees expressed its appreciation and gratitude to Mr Krishna Mohan for successfully discharging the duties of General Secretary during the difficult and challenging period of the last two months. The annual accounts for the fiscal year 2025-26 were presented, showing total income of Rs. 237 crore and expenditure of Rs. 91 crore. Additionally, capital expenditures for construction and other projects totalled Rs. 425 crore. At the end of the year, March 31, 2026, the Trust had a total available balance of Rs. 1,882 crore. The Board of Trustees approved the accounts. The meeting also reviewed the progress of the investigation by the Special Investigation Team into the offering theft and updates on the matter in the Supreme Court.

Preliminary study planned for Sular flyover

Chennai, Sep 3: A preliminary feasibility study has been planned for a flyover covering a live-kn stretch of NH-81 through Sular in Coimbatore district, with the state government set to approach the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) for in-principle approval.

Public Works Minister Aadhar Arjuna informed the state assembly that a detailed study would be taken up only after NHAI grants the initial approval. The proposal is aimed at addressing growing traffic requirements in Sular and surrounding areas.

The minister was responding to a question from Sular MLA Sukumar during Question Hour on whether the government would construct an elevated corridor through the central part of Sular.

Arjuna said NH-81 falls under the control of NHAI and the first step would therefore be to obtain in-principle clearance from the authority for examining the feasibility of the flyover along the five-km stretch.

Once clearance is received, a detailed study will assess the feasibility and requirements of the proposed structure. Based on its findings, a project proposal and recommendations will be submitted to senior NHAI authorities for consideration and approval. The minister also said NHAI

had appointed a consultant to prepare a detailed project report (DPR) for a proposed greenfield corridor between Tiruchirappalli and Coimbatore.

Further decisions on the Sular flyover

1,300 new anganwadi buildings planned this year

Chennai, Sep 3: The Tamil Nadu government will construct 1,300 new buildings for anganwadis across rural and urban areas this year, while also making up repairs to existing centres, Social Welfare and Women's Rights Minister K Jagatheeswarar told the state assembly on Wednesday. Responding to a question raised by Dhanuapuri MLA Sowmya Anubamini, the minister said 1,000 buildings would be constructed in rural areas through the District Rural Development Agencies and another 300 in urban areas through the Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department. Dilapidated buildings would be demolished and replaced with new structures.

Tamil Nadu currently has 54,481 anganwadi centres, of which 42,223 function from their own buildings. Another 5,073 operate from other permanent buildings, while 7,185

would be taken after considering projected traffic growth, existing road infrastructure and long-term transport requirements in Sular and neighbouring areas, he added.

Jagatheeswarar said additional anganwadi buildings would also be constructed using funds available under various Central and state government schemes, discretionary funds under district collectors and corporate social responsibility contributions from companies. Apart from constructing new buildings, the government would undertake repairs to existing anganwadi centres during the current year, he said.

Sowmya Anubamini had sought to know whether the government would construct a new building for the child care centre at Chinnampatti in Adhappadi panchayat in Dhanuapuri constituency. The minister assured the assembly that the MLA's request would be taken up.
