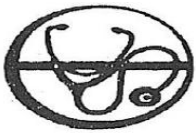

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RAMAPPA TEMPLE PRESERVATION MUST BE GIVEN TOP PRIORITY-COLLECTOR

Mulugu, September 8 (TSPT) Mulugu District Collector Borkhate Hemant Sahadeo Rao has directed officials to accord the highest priority to the preservation and protection of the historic Ramappa Temple, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. A meeting of the Ramappa Temple Special Development Authority Committee was held on Tuesday at the V. L. Rao Conference Hall of the Integrated District Offices Complex under the chairmanship of the District Collector. The committee discussed in detail the precautionary measures required to ensure that the Kakatiya Rudreshwara (Ramappa) Temple is not affected by the open-cast mining activities proposed in the Venkatapur mandal area. The meeting also deliberated on the proposal to issue a No Objection Certificate (NOC) for the establishment of the open-cast mine.

BRS stages protest against Congress government in Mancherial

Mancherial, Sept. 8, TSPT : The Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) on Tuesday staged a protest in Mancherial as part of its statewide agitation against the Congress government, alleging that the ruling party had failed to fulfil its election promises. The protest, led by BRS State leader Nadipelli Vijith Rao, saw a large number of party leaders and workers participating. The protesters alleged that the government had neglected the welfare of farmers, women, youth and other sections of society during its tenure. The BRS leaders took out a rally through the district headquarters and staged a road blockade on the main road.

Collector directs banks to speed up loan disbursements

Jogulamba Gadwal TSPT: District Collector Ravi Shankar Shukla has directed banks to ensure timely and adequate credit facilities to all eligible beneficiaries and accelerate loan disbursements under various government welfare and development schemes. The Collector was speaking at the District Consultative Committee (DCC) and District Level Review Committee (DLRC) meeting held at the District Collector's Office on Tuesday. He stressed the need for close coordination between banks and government departments to achieve the prescribed loan targets within the stipulated time-frame. He instructed banks to sanction loans to eligible beneficiaries under various government schemes, including the Pradhan Mantri Dhan-Dhanya Krishi Yojana (PMDDKY) and the Pradhan Mantri Kisan MUDRA Yojana (PMKMY).

Similarly, in the MSME sector, banks achieved Rs.335.05 crore (52.29 per cent) against the March 31 target of Rs.63.80 crore, while only Rs.205.56 crore (29.71 per cent) was achieved against the June 30 target of Rs.69.18 crore. The Collector called for greater disbursement of MUDRA, housing and agriculture loans, besides expanding banking services in rural areas. He also directed officials to conduct extensive financial literacy programmes and increase public participation in such camps. He stressed the need to educate people about the risks and high interest burden associated with borrowing from non-banking financial institutions and private lenders. He suggested using various media, such as posters, videos, PowerPoint presentations and real-life experiences of affected borrowers to create greater awareness.

Mahila Congress Demands Removal of BRS MLC Tata Madhu Over Remarks Against Speaker

Hyderabad, TSPT: Telangana Pradesh Mahila Congress on Tuesday demanded the immediate removal of BRS MLC Tata Madhu over his alleged objectionable and insulting remarks against Telangana Legislative Assembly Speaker Gaddam Prasad Kumar. Led by Telangana Pradesh Mahila Congress president Swarni Swarni women Congress leaders from Kharabhat, Secundrabad and Medchal districts staged a protest near the B.R. Ambedkar statue at Lower Tank Bund in Hyderabad. The protesters strongly condemned Tata Madhu's remarks and burnt his effigy. Addressing the protest, Mahila Congress leaders said it was highly unfortunate

that a legislator, who was expected to uphold the dignity of democratic institutions, had allegedly made remarks that demoted the constitutional office of the Assembly Speaker. They alleged that the episode once again exposed what they described as the BRS leadership's disrespectful attitude towards women and its disregard for Dalits.
