NCDEX may relaunch pepper futures by end-June

The National Commodity and Derivatives Exchange (NCDEX) is preparing to relaunch pepper futures by the end of June.

The contract could be among the first agri derivatives to benefit from the market regulator's proposed cash-settlement-first framework, sources said.

Pepper futures were among the NCDEX's most actively traded spice contracts in the early 2010s before being discontinued due to quality disputes and delivery-related litigation.

With most of the legacy issues now resolved, the exchange is set to reintroduce the contract.

NCDEX has secured the required regulatory approvals and established warehousing infrastructure in Kerala, which is expected

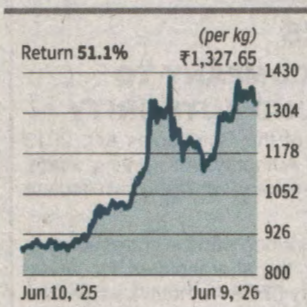
to serve as the base delivery centre.

The relaunch is expected to support the NCDEX's ef-

forts to expand its presence in South India. The relaunch could strengthen domestic pepper price discovery, redu-

cing reliance on Vietnam-driven global benchmarks despite India being a major producer.
