The demand pertains to alleged excess/wrong availment of input tax credit.

The Company does not accept the demand raised by the GST department and intends to file an appeal against the aforesaid Order before the concerned Appellate Authority or take any other appropriate action as advised by legal advisors to protect the interest of the Company.
