Pursuant to Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, we wish to inform the exchange about further positive development regarding an ongoing complaint (FIR 0012/2026) initially intimated on 26th December 2025 with the Police Station Bamitha, District Chhatarpur, Madhya Pradesh.

The Company has successfully received Rs.1,34,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore Thirty Four Lakh) in its bank account from sellers, in strict compliance with the order of Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh, Jabalpur Bench.

Financial Implications & Status of Total Transaction Value:

This development has secured the immediate recovery of Rs. 1.34 Crores of the Company's capital. This retrieval of blocked funds will be utilized for the Company's ongoing business operations.



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Shareholders and stakeholders are further informed that the original consideration paid by the Company under the said disputed sale deed was Rs. 1.79 Crores out of which Rs.1.34 Crore has been successfully credited back in company's Bank Account.

However, the Company strictly reserves its legal rights and remedies under the law to pursue the recovery of the remaining balance of approximately Rs. 45 Lakhs from the other co-accused/intermediaries involved in the dispute. The Company is also proceeding with the formal cancellation of the disputed sale deed as per the judicial directives.

The details as required under SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-1/P/CIR/2023/123 dated July 13, 2023, are enclosed herewith as Annexure A.
