To the Members of the Company,

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 110 read with Section 108 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 ("Companies Act"), read with Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 ("Rules"), (including any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof, for the time being in force), Secretarial Standard on General Meetings ("SS-2"), Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("SEBI Listing Regulations") and other applicable laws and regulations, it is proposed to seek the consent of the members ("Members") of QUEST FLOW CONTROLS LIMITED (Formerly Known as Meson Valves India Limited) ("Company"), for the resolutions appended below, through Remote Electronic Voting ("E-Voting") only.

An Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Act and other applicable provisions of the Act, pertaining to the resolution setting out the material facts and the reasons thereof, is appended, Pursuant to Rule 22(5) of the Rules.

The Board of Directors ("**Board**") in its meeting held on Friday, November 28, 2025 has appointed M/s. Nikunj Kanabar & Associates, Practicing Company Secretary, as the Scrutinizer for conducting the Postal Ballot and E-Voting process in a fair and transparent manner. He has communicated his willingness to be appointed and will be available for the said purpose.

Section 110 of the Act and the Rules provide for passing of resolutions by postal ballot. In terms of said Section of the Act and the Rules, a Company may, and in case of resolutions relating to such business as the Central Government may, by notification, declare to be conducted only by postal ballot, shall, get any resolution (other than ordinary business and any business in respect of which directors or auditors have right to be heard at any meeting) passed by means of postal ballot, instead of transacting the business in general meeting of the Company.

Further, in terms of the circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA") vide its General Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 08, 2020 and General Circular No. 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020 read with other relevant circulars issued in this regard, the latest being General Circular No. 09/2024 dated September 19, 2024 issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("General Circulars") ("MCA Circulars"), Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("SEBI Listing Regulations"), and other applicable provisions of the Act, rules, circulars and notifications issued thereunder, that the resolution(s) appended below are proposed to be passed by the shareholders of the QUEST FLOW CONTROLS LIMITED (Formerly Known as Meson Valves India Limited) ("Company") through postal ballot by remote e-Voting process ("E-Voting").

In compliance with the requirements of the MCA Circulars, Members are required to communicate their assent or dissent through the remote e-voting system only. You are requested to carefully read all the instructions given in the Notes. E-Voting shall commence on Wednesday, December 10, 2025 (9.00 a.m. IST), and ends on Thursday, January 08, 2026 (5.00 p.m. IST). The Scrutinizer shall submit his report to the Chairman of the Company after completion of scrutiny of the e-voting on or before Monday, January 12, 2026 and, the results of the voting shall be declared by the Chairman of the Company on or before Monday, January 12, 2026 at Company's Registered Office. 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- 5. Upon confirmation, the message "Vote cast successfully" will be displayed.

- 7. Once you confirm your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.
