Z-Tech (India) Secures Order from Nagar Nigam Ayodhya, Uttar Pradesh for “Luv-Kush Park on Waste to Wonder theme” under Smart City Mission

The park will include key zones such as the **Ramayana Story Mural Zone, Luv Kush Story Zone, Adbhut Kahaniya Zone, Selfie Zone, Archery Arena, Horse Ride Area, and Valmiki Training Obstacle Course**, making it engaging for children, families, tourists, and devotees.

To make the experience more engaging and contemporary, we are bringing together the ideas of waste-to-art and technology through a dedicated projection mapping zone. In this zone, important scenes from the Ramayana and the stories of Luv Kush will come alive in the evening through light, sound, and animation.
