Sub: Update on Disruption in Operations at some of the manufacturing sites at Haridwar

In continuation to the intimation given by the Akums Drugs and Pharmaceuticals Limited ("the Company") dated 14th May, 2026, this is to inform that this event was occurred industry-wide, primarily triggered for review of minimum wages by the state authorities; and this affected not only pharmaceutical sector, but all major industrial towns & manufacturing facilities situated in the state of Uttarakhand.

Further, manufacturing operations at the affected sites of the Company and its subsidiaries have been successfully resumed at over 70% of its operations with effect from 16th May, 2026. The resumption is expected to progressively improve productivity levels. Local authorities are actively coordinating with the industries across the region to restore the normalcy.
