IMFA acquires ferro chrome plant

Chennai, Feb 28: Indian Metals & Ferro Alloys Ltd the country's leading fully integrated producer of value-added ferro chrome, has announced the completion of the strategic acquisition of Tata Steel Limited's (TSL) ferro chrome plant in Kalinganagar, Odisha. The transaction is valued at Rs 707.26 crore comprising base consideration of Rs 610 crore along with GST and net working capital, and has been funded entirely from internal accruals.

Spread across 115 acres in Kalinganagar, the newly-acquired facility consists of four furnaces capable of producing 100,000 tonnes per annum (tpa) annually which will further increase to 150,000 tpa when the partially built fifth furnace is commissioned in approximately one year.

Commenting on the acquisition, Subhrakant Panda, Managing Director, IMFA said: "It is a transformative deal which marks

a key milestone in the company's growth journey. We are committed to creating value for all stakeholders by working towards a smooth and seamless integration which delivers significant operational synergies. Together with our greenfield

expansion, it positions us as India's largest producer of ferro chrome and amongst the foremost globally. We will continue to shape the future of ferro chrome - responsibly, sustainably and ambitiously."

PhonePe's AI-powered natural language search

Chennai, Feb 28: PhonePe has introduced an AI-powered natural language search feature built using Microsoft Foundry, enabling users to complete in-app tasks through simple text or voice commands.

The new feature replaces traditional navigation with intent-based routing. For example, commands like "Pay Hemant 20 rupees", "Recharge FASTag," or "Gold price" directly take users to the relevant payment or information page, with recipients or services pre-selected where applicable.

Powered by a hybrid model combining on-device and cloud inferencing, the system understands user intent-whether for payments, purchases, or support-while ensuring privacy. No personal or transactional data leaves the PhonePe environment.

Rahul Chari, Founder, Wholesale Director & CTO, said the launch marks a shift from utility-driven payment apps to intelligent, user-centric platforms that anticipate customer needs while maintaining strong privacy and security standards.

Vijay's wife Sangeetha files for divorce

Chengalappattu, Feb. 27: The sangeetha sornalingam, wife of actor-politician Joseph Vijay Chandrasekhar-popularly known as Vijay and leader of the Tamilaga Vettri Kazhagam party-has filed a petition for divorce in the Chengalappattu Family Court, setting in motion legal proceedings after more than two decades

of marriage. The petition was formally lodged on February 24 and is scheduled for its next hearing on April 20, 2026.

In her divorce plea, Sangeetha alleged that Vijay was involved in an extramarital relationship with an actress, claims she says she became aware of in 2021. She stated that despite assurances that the relationship would end, it

continued, prompting her decision to seek a legal separation under relevant provisions of the Special Marriage Act.

The couple, who married on August 25, 1999, have two children, Jason Sanjay and Divya Shasha. Reports indicate that they had been living separately for the past two years before the formal divorce petition was filed.

Legal experts note that divorce petitions citing infidelity and cruelty are permitted under Sections 27(1)(a) and 27(1)(d) of the Special Marriage Act, which allow spouses to seek dissolution on such grounds if they prove cruelty or adultery. Sangeetha's filing alleges behaviour she considers incompatible with continuing the marriage and seeks the court's
