# Voters, officials brave the sweltering heat on polling day

CHENNAI

Despite extreme heat and humid weather, voters lined up at polling stations across the city, with many witnessing brisk turnout in the morning. In Chennai, where Nungambakkam recorded 35 degrees Celsius and Meenambakkam 37.5 degrees Celsius, many voters, particularly senior citizens, queued up early to cast their vote.

The Regional Meteorological Centre has continued its heat stress warning for coastal areas, including Puducherry and Karaikal. Interior areas also sizzled on Thursday, with the maximum temperature rising by two-three degrees Celsius. Vellore recorded the hottest day temperature of 40.7 degrees Celsius in the State. The mercury level peaked above the 40-degree mark in Madurai and

Karur as well. Many polling stations saw massive crowds right from the morning. Field visits by *The Hindu's* reporters found that several polling stations had arrangements, including *shamianas*, to provide cover from the heat, drinking water facilities, and medical teams.

Not only voters, but also polling staff, police personnel, booth agents, and other party workers braved

the heat. Party workers were also seen distributing water bottles in some places.

In Royapuram and Dr. Radhakrishnan Nagar constituencies in north Chennai, a large number of voters turned up at the polling stations by noon, undeterred by the merciless heat.

T. Sudharsanam, of Kolathur constituency, said he and his family voted early in the day to avoid

the scorching sun. "We went to the polling booth at 7.30 a.m. In fact, many residents voted by noon, after which the numbers turned steady," he said.

Residents of parts of Uthandi had to travel 10 km in searing heat to cast their votes, as they were assigned polling stations in Puzhuthivakkam or Pallikaranai. With polling booths located on narrow streets, some of them had to walk about 600 m from the

parking area and wait in long queues.

K. Jeyvarshini, of Uthandi, had to travel with her one-month old infant to the polling booth in Pallikaranai at noon. "I couldn't leave my baby at home as I had to be away for long hours to cast my vote. But I managed to vote within a few minutes despite the long queue. I was given special concession to vote directly because I had my baby with me," she said.

## Odisha issues SOP for safety of Census enumerators

After incidents of attack on Census enumerators in Odisha, the State government on Thursday issued a standard operating procedure (SOP) asking them to skip

specific houses if they face hostility. The left out houses would later be covered with protection.

While the first phase of Census 2027 – the Housing and Housing Census – is currently under way from April 16, 2026, the

enumerators were chased away at some places.

In Kamakhyanager area in Dhenkanal district, enumerators were physically assaulted and their vehicles were damaged. A similar incident was reported from the Tangi area of

Khordha district.

“The government has issued an SOP to ensure the safety and security of Census functionaries,” said Arabinda Kumar Padhee, State Revenue and Disaster Management Secretary, in a letter to all Collectors.

## In Modi roadshow, CAA promise & jhalmuri jibe

AS WEST Bengal voted in the first phase of Assembly polls on Thursday, Prime Minister Narendra Modi began his campaign for the second phase of the Assembly elections. Addressing a rally at Krishnanagar in Nadia district, Modi took a jibe at the ruling Trinamool Congress over its reaction to him eating jhalmuri in Jhargram during an election campaign in the first phase.

"On May 4, the BJP will be victorious in West Bengal, and sweets and jhalmuri (snack made of puffed rice) will be distributed. I have heard that jhalmuri gave them a big shock. Jhalmuri maine khayai par jhal TMC kolagahai (It was I who had eaten the jhalmuri, but the heat was felt by the Trinamool Congress)," he said.

Commending the Election Commission, he said, "This is the first election of its kind in the last 50 years in which violence has been kept to an absolute minimum. Previously, it was common practice to hang someone every week and simply claim it

## Mamata: High voter turnout shows we are in driver's seat

ASSERTING SHE has a firm grasp on the public pulse, West Bengal CM Mamata Banerjee said the Trinamool Congress (TMC) is already in the "driver's seat" following the high voter turnout in the first phase of polling on Thursday. She claimed that despite large-scale deletions, the turnout was high, "because people know that this is their battle to save their rights."

Addressing a gathering at the Bowbazar-Chowringhee crossing, the TMC supremo attacked PM Narendra Modi and the BJP, accusing them of spreading lies and threatening the state administration, as well as neglecting Bengal's interests until election season. "If I can understand the

pulse of the people, then let me tell you that we are already in the driver's seat," she said, adding, "I don't disrespect a chair or launch personal attacks. However, the person sitting on the chair must also know how to respect the chair. If they disrespect others and spread lies, I will not tolerate it."

"They will try to implement the NRC. They wanted to delimitation," Banerjee added. Taking a dig at Modi, the CM said: "You said that you will eat jhal-muri after you win. We will treat you with 'bhelpuri' (a popular street food). That's easily available in Delhi. Remember, I can eat your dhokla and dosa. But have you ever tasted fish, meat and rice?"

Banerjee also accused Modi of trying to threaten the administration.

## I-PAC raid: SG, senior counsel exchange barbs in Apex court

New Delhi, April 23

THE SUPREME Court on Thursday witnessed a heated exchange between Solicitor General Tushar Mehta and Senior Advocate Menaka Guruswamy. While Guruswamy complained that proceedings in the Enforcement Directorate's (ED) petition against Mamata Banerjee, in connection with the raid on political consultancy firm I-PAC, were being used for political purposes and posted "by a major political party" on its social media handle, Mehta said the clip may have gained traction because she was comparing the West Bengal government to the crown.

"My friend is using Your Lordships proceedings as a social media weapon in a political campaign. Your Lordships know this," Guruswamy told a bench of Justices P K Mishra and N V Anjaria as soon as Mehta, appearing for the ED, stood up to make his arguments on the question of maintainability of the writ petition filed by the agency under Article 32 of the Constitution.

A video of Wednesday's hearing wherein the bench refused to agree with Guruswamy's submissions that it was essentially a Centre-state dispute for which the remedy lay in filing a suit under Article 131 went viral on social media. The counsel, in the course of the arguments, cited jurist H M Seervai's commentary on the Constitution wherein he had cited that "there can be no mandamus against the crown". She said, "There can be no mandamus to the sovereign, there can be no doubt, both because there would be an incongruity in the Queen commanding herself to do an act...". Justice Mishra had then queried, "Who is the queen here?"

Mehta had then questioned if Guruswamy was comparing the respondents to the crown. "Are the respondents crown?... Fortunately, we are in a democracy. Nobody is a crown."

As the video of the hearing spread, social media users wondered whether Guruswamy was referring to Banerjee as the queen. On Thursday, Guruswamy said that though Mehta was saying he would argue on maintainability, he was actually arguing on the facts of the case. Mehta said he was on maintainability, but was not giving a lecture on it. Guruswamy then referred to the video on social media. Justice Mishra said, "We saw it". Objecting to the interruption, the Solicitor General asked Guruswamy to sit down, to which she replied: "Don't talk to me like that ..."

Besides reaffirming Yogi's status of being the party's central figure in UP, Nabin's stance removes ambiguity about leadership, if any while seeking to consolidate party cadres around chief authority well ahead an intense battle.

BJP in UP is known to have multiple power centres - organisational leaders, regional satraps and caste-based influencers. Yogi's endorsement in public by Nabin may thus serve as a signal to prevent leadership speculation, even as ticket distribution and alliances become contentious closer to elections.

Analysts said announcing Yogi as the face early is also a move to counter opposition parties like Samajwadi Party and Congress which have been pushing the poll narrative around unemployment, inflation, and social exaltations.

Analysts, however, maintain that projecting Yogi for a possible third consecutive term brings anti-incumbency into play. This is crucial even as the opposition attempts to ratchet up its "Plehbha, Dalit, Apsankhyak (PDA)" poll narrative, which is said to have dented BJP in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections.

# Kharge replies to EC show-cause notice

**New Delhi:** Denying that there was any violation of model code of conduct (MCC), Congress has told EC and party president Mallikarjun Kharge had clarified that his remark about Modi being a "terrorist" was made in the context of Modi "terrorising people and political parties" through threats of agencies like ED, IT and CBI, and by wanting to take over the limitation in his own hands. Congress also sought a week's time to file a detailed reply to the show-cause notice issued to Kharge on Wednesday.

In the reply to EC's show-cause notice, Congress general secretary Jayant Bhambhani said Kharge's clarification on his remark was available, and the EC notice appeared to have been hastily issued without application of mind by officials. He called it "deliberate over-booking" of the explanation of the context in which Kharge had used the word 'terrorist'. "Unfortunately, it smacks of ulterior motives," he said.

**HC seeks AAP reply to sharing court videos**

Court orders X to remove videos of hearing; counsel for Meta Platforms and Google says links already taken down; next hearing posted for July 6

The Delhi High Court on Thursday asked Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leaders Arvind Kejriwal, Manish Sisodia and Sanjay Singh, Congress leader Digvijaya Singh and others to respond to a plea seeking contempt action against them for allegedly uploading and sharing clips of the excise case court hearing online.

A Bench of Justice V. Kammeswar Rao and Justice Manmeet P.S. Arora issued notice to them on the petition by advocate Vaibhav Singh and directed social media platforms to take down the videos of the April 13 hearing on Mr. Kejriwal's plea seeking recusal of Justice Swarana Kanta

Sharma in the excise policy case. "We are concerned with the larger interest of the institution. Otherwise, if we don't control this, it would go on," the court remarked. It said the unauthorised recording, uploading and publishing of court hearings is prohibited under High Court rules. Counsel for Meta Plat-

forms and Google said the links flagged by the petitioner had been taken down.

The court also ordered X to remove videos of the same hearing in which AAP chief Kejriwal had appeared in person to argue his case. The court posted the matter for hearing on July 6.

**Odisha issues SOP for safety of Census enumerators following cases of attack**

After incidents of attack on Census enumerators in Odisha, the State government on Thursday issued a standard operating procedure (SOP) asking them to skip specific houses if they face hostility. The left out houses would later be covered with protection.

While the first phase of Census 2027 – the House-listing and Housing Census – is currently under way

from April 16, 2026, and will continue till May 15, the enumerators were chased away at some places.

In Kamakhyanager area in Dhenkanal district, enumerators were physically assaulted and their vehicles were damaged. Subsequently, police had to intervene and arrest troublemakers. A similar incident was reported from the Tangi area of Khordha district.

"The government has is-

sued an SOP to ensure the safety and security of Census functionaries, particularly at the enumerator and supervisor (E&S) levels, and to facilitate smooth and timely completion of Census work," said Arabinda Kumar Padhee, State Revenue and Disaster Management Secretary, in a letter to all Collectors.

"Names and contact details of E&S must be shared with the respective police station," the SOP states.

**I-PAC director Chandel sent to judicial custody**

THE MEN WHO VANISHED IN THE 2006 MALEGAON BLASTS CASE

## Seven accused, including a Pakistani, were never found

NEARLY TWO decades after four coordinated blasts ripped through Malegaon on a Friday afternoon in September 2006, killing 31 people and injuring over 300, the case stands in a peculiar limbo. Two separate investigations, carried out years apart, named two entirely different sets of accused. Today, 13 of those accused across both groups have been discharged. No one remains to face trial. And yet, the case is far from closed.

Seven men named across the two investigations have, over the years, vanished without a trace. Despite the involvement of the country's top investigative agencies, their whereabouts remain unknown, leaving behind unanswered questions and grieving families.

### ATS & CBI probe: 4 men who disappeared

The blasts took place on September 8, 2006. Three explosions struck the premises of Hamidia Masjid and Bada Kabrastan moments after Friday prayers, while a fourth detonated at Mushawarat Chowk nearby.

The Maharashtra Anti-Terrorism Squad (ATS), which first investigated the case, arrested nine men and accused a total of 13 individuals of being part of a conspiracy that, according to investigators, had taken shape months earlier at a wedding gathering. But even as arrests were made, four men named in the chargesheet were never found.

One of them, Mumazzil, was identified as a Pakistani national. The other three — Munawwar Ahmed, Riyaz Ahmed Shafi Ahmed, and Ishtiyaq Ahmed Mohammed Isaq, all residents of Malegaon — disap-

peared in October 2006, barely a month after the blasts.

Munawwar, then 36, was described in the chargesheet as a key conspirator who allegedly directed that the blasts be carried out at the mosque and cemetery complex. Riyaz was accused of placing an improvised explosive device at one of the sites, while Ishtiyaq was named as part of the wider conspiracy.

Munawwar's father, Mohammed Amin, now in his seventies, lives in a tin-sheet structure on the outskirts of Malegaon. A former muezzin, he has spent years without closure on his son's whereabouts. "People say losing a child is the greatest pain. For us, it is worse — we do not even know if our son is alive or dead," he said in an earlier interview.

Riyaz's family points to a troubling contradiction. Known to have been under police surveillance due to alleged SIMI links, he was frequently called in for questioning. "For someone who was under constant surveillance, it is surprising that he was made an accused in the first place. The bigger surprise is how he was allowed to disappear despite



being watched. Either the system failed completely, or there is something we are not being told." Little is known about Ishtiyaq's family.

### NIA probe: 3 more who can't be found

Years after the ATS wrapped up its investigation, the case took a dramatic turn. The National Investigation Agency, which took over in 2011, filed a chargesheet in 2013 pointing at an entirely different set of accused — this time linking the blasts to a right-wing extremist network. The NIA simultaneously dropped the original accused from its chargesheet, declaring the earlier nine men innocent.

Among those newly named were Ramchandra (Ramji) Kalsangra, Sandeep Dange, and Ramesh Mahalkar — three men who, like their counterparts in the earlier probe, could not be traced.

According to the NIA chargesheet, Kalsangra was accused of planting the bomb, Dange of guiding the operation, and Mahalkar of assembling the explosives in Indore.

Kalsangra, an electrical contractor from Indore, led what

appeared to be a modest and stable life before his sudden disappearance around 2008. Living with his family in the city's Bengali Colony, he left home one day for work and never returned. His name later surfaced prominently in investigations after statements by Swami Aseemanand linked him to a wider network. Authorities announced a cash reward for information on him, but he has remained untraceable. He is survived by his wife, Lakshmi Devi, and their three sons.

Sandeep Dange, also from Indore, trained as an electrical engineer and was associated with right-wing organisations. His father, a retired employee of the state education department in Madhya Pradesh, has largely withdrawn from public life following the allegations. Ramesh Mahalkar, a resident of Nanded, remains the least documented of the three.

All three have been named in multiple blast cases across the country and continue to feature on the NIA's list of most wanted accused, including in the Samjhauta Express blast case.

In 2009, suspended Maharashtra Assistant Police Inspector Mehboob Mujawar, in an affidavit before a Solapur court, claimed that Kalsangra and Dange had died in the custody of the Maharashtra ATS, and that their bodies were disposed of as victims of the November 2008 terror attacks. The allegation has never been officially substantiated.

### No accused, no answers

The seven missing men are the last loose thread in a case that has otherwise wound down without resolution. The nine men arrested by the ATS were discharged in 2016. The four men charged by the NIA had their charges quashed by the Bombay High Court this week.

## Gaikwad in fresh row over 'threat' to publisher over Pansare book

**He allegedly objected to the title of the book on Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj**

SHIV SENA MLA from Buldhana Sanjay Gaikwad was accused of abusing and threatening a publisher over a book on Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, with a purported audio clip of the exchange going viral on social media.

The row centres on Kolhapur-based publisher Prashant Ambi, who alleged that Gaikwad called him earlier this week and spoke for around nine minutes, objecting to the title of the book "Shivaji Kon Hota?" and using abusive language.

The book, written by CPI leader and rationalist Govind Pansare and first published in 1988, has long been in circulation and previously faced objections over its title. Ambi alleged that the MLA threatened to "cut his tongue" and warned of physical assault, even invoking Pansare in a remark that has drawn sharp reactions. He said he repeatedly clarified that he

was only the publisher and urged Gaikwad to read the book before forming an opinion.

"I kept telling him to read the book first and understand its context, but he was not interested," Ambi said, adding that he plans to file a complaint at a police station in Kolhapur. Police officials said no complaint had been received at the time of filing this report.

Responding to the controversy, Gaikwad confirmed making the call but claimed the clip was "edited and distorted". He maintained that the book distorts history and objected to what he described as a disrespectful reference to Shivaji Maharaj. "I have done nothing wrong... such people deserve to be abused," he said, adding that he reacted after being provoked.

Reacting to the incident, Medha Pansare, daughter of the slain rationalist, said threats cannot counter ideas. "You cannot kill an idea. Read the book first, then comment," she said, adding that legal op-

## TCS BPO case: Retd judge should probe, say civil society groups

STATING THEY did not trust Nashik City police that is probing the TCS BPO case — which comprises allegations of sexual harassment and religious conversion — several civil society groups on Thursday sought a probe by a retired High Court judge in the matter.

Various groups — including Association for Protection of Civil Rights (APCR), People's Union for Civil Liberties (PUCIL), Citizen for Peace and Justice and activists like Niranjana Takle — addressed the media at the Mumbai Press Club and raised questions.

Takle said, "There should be a narco test of all the accused, victim and those working at the Nashik office of TCS so that the truth can be uncovered."

APCR national secretary Nadeem Khan said, "The way the media has used the incident to tarnish an entire community will lead to other companies too being scared to hire people from the community."



## KEM Hospital gets advanced 3D mammography system

**Mumbai:** The Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation-run King Edward Memorial Hospital (KEM Hospital) has installed a state-of-the-art 3D Digital Tomosynthesis Mammography machine, a move expected to significantly strengthen early detection and diagnosis of breast cancer in the city's public healthcare system.

According to doctors, the new system can complete breast imaging in about five minutes and detect tumours as small as 70 microns. It can identify cancer up to 15 months earlier than conventional 2D mammography machines, enabling earlier intervention and improving treatment outcomes. The technology also re-

duces radiation exposure by nearly 30 per cent compared to older analogue systems and is designed to minimise discomfort for patients during the screening process.

In addition, biopsy procedures can now be performed in approximately 13 minutes, significantly reducing waiting and procedure time. **ENS**

The new machine is expected to significantly strengthen early detection of breast cancer.
