# Global South to decide on the new world order

“We in the West have to understand that unless we change our conduct towards the Global South, we could lose this game. We’re currently looking at a new state of balance that’s about a battle between values, power and interests.” In his appearances around the world, Alexander Stubb, Finland’s President since 2024, has consistently debated the question of transformation of the global order.

In Addis Ababa, Stubb ran in the Ethiopian mountains together with Olympic gold medalist Haile Gebrselassie. With his interest in sports, Stubb is an excellent example of a healthy lifestyle. Maybe public health will improve if some people follow the president’s example and go for a run? Stubb is an avid triathlete and also knows something about golf and ice hockey.

Stubb became the chair of his party in 2014 when his Jyri Katainen became EU Commissioner, a job Stubb himself had dreamt of. He served as Finland’s foreign trade minister, Prime Minister and finance minister before being challenged as party leader by current Prime Minister Petteri Orpo in 2016 and losing. By the way, it was Orpo who asked Stubb to become a presidential candidate.

Finland has also previously had presidents with an international profile, but Stubb has both studied and worked abroad. At home, he speaks English with his British lawyer wife, and Swedish with his children. After his political career, he worked in the European Central Bank, and as professor in Italy. From there, he was nominated to be a presidential candidate.

Unlike many other countries, Finland’s president is not symbolic. The president leads foreign policy together with the government, is commander-in-chief of the armed forces and appoints high-ranking officials. Despite the fact that presidents usually symbolically give up their party memberships.

Many see the president as an opinion maker and an example for the citizens. A popular habit in many Finnish families is to watch the president’s New Year’s address on national TV. Finland will take all memberships seriously. Non-alignment is a thing of the past and the political contacts with Russia have been frozen due to its aggression in Ukraine.

# CONFLICT DEEPENS | Israeli attacks in Tehran, Lebanon escalate tensions

## Iran strikes across West Asia

Iran launched a Khorramshahr-4 heavy ballistic missile towards Israel early on Thursday, state media reported, as the West Asia conflict escalated on Day 6. The missile can reportedly carry a one-tonne warhead and has an estimated range of about 2,000 km. The Iranian Revolutionary Guards targeted Ben Gurion Airport and airbase near Israeli capital Tel Aviv. Israel reported multiple incoming missile attacks, with air raid sirens sounding in Tel Aviv and Jerusalem shortly after the Israeli military announced fresh strikes in Lebanon targeting the Iran-backed militant group Hezbollah in the southern suburbs of Beirut.

Countries across the region were bracing for further escalation on Thursday, a day after Iran’s paramilitary Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps warned of the “complete decimation of the region’s military and economic infrastructure”. Authorities in Qatar said residents near the US Embassy in Doha were being evacuated as a pre-

caution, though officials did not provide further details. In the UAE, fighter jets were heard flying over Dubai in the morning as tensions across the region intensified. There were indications the conflict could begin affecting commercial shipping. A blast was reported on Thursday off the coast of Kuwait.

1,230 deaths reported in Iran since hostilities escalated, according to an Iranian agency.

The United Kingdom Maritime Trade Operations centre, operated by the British military, said a tanker appeared to have come under attack but did not confirm the cause. In previous incidents, Iran has targeted ships using limpet mines attached to vessels. In Azerbaijan’s Nakhchivan exclave, suspected Iranian drones struck near Nakhchivan International Airport. Azerbaijani authorities said one drone hit airport infrastructure while another landed near a nearby school building. Two civilians were

injured in the incident. Azerbaijan accused Iran of carrying out the attack, while Iranian officials denied targeting neighbouring countries, according to statements reported by regional broadcasters. In Oman, Iranian drones targeted maritime and port infrastructure along the coast. Strikes were reported near the Port of Duqm and the Port of Salalah. An oil tanker off the coast of Muscat was also hit, maritime monitoring agencies said. One crew member aboard the tanker was killed and four others were injured. A foreign worker at a port facility was also reported injured, according to local authorities.

Iran also launched ballistic missiles and drones towards US military facilities and strategic infrastructure in parts of the Gulf region. Several projectiles were intercepted over Saudi Arabia and Turkey, regional defence authorities said. No casualties were reported from the interceptions. Israel continued air strikes on Iranian-linked military facilities and strategic targets, according to international conflict trackers and Israeli defence officials.

## Proxies hit Israeli, US-linked targets

Iran-backed armed groups launched coordinated attacks across West Asia, targeting Israeli territory and facilities linked to US interests, according to Reuters. “The Guardian” and regional security monitoring groups.

In Lebanon, the Iranian-backed group Hezbollah fired rockets and drones towards northern Israel as cross-border hostilities intensified. Israeli authorities said air defence systems intercepted several projectiles, though some landed in open areas. Damage was reported in northern Israel, but officials did not release a detailed casualty count linked

specifically to the latest salvo. Hezbollah has been exchanging fire with Israel for months, but the pace of attacks has increased as tensions between Iran, Israel and the US escalate across the region. Israeli forces responded with air strikes on targets in southern Lebanon following the launches.

## STRAIT OF HORMUZ CLOSED TO US, ISRAELI SHIPS, OPEN TO OTHERS: IRAN

Iran has announced that the Strait of Hormuz will be closed to ships linked to the US, Israel and their allies, while vessels from other countries will still be allowed to pass through the strategic waterway, according to Iran’s Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) and reports by Iranian state media including IRNA and Tasnim News Agency. Iranian authorities said the restriction applies specifically to vessels associated with the US, Israel and certain Western nations, warning that such ships entering the strait could face military action. However, Tehran said ships from other countries would still be permitted to use the route, Iranian media reported.

US WILL BITTERLY REGRET: ARAGHCHI

Iran’s Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi warned that the US would “bitterly regret” sinking an Iranian naval vessel in the Indian Ocean, as tensions escalated sharply between Iran, Israel and US forces across the region. On X, Araghchi condemned the attack on the Iranian frigate IRIS Dana, describing it as an “atrocity at sea”. “The US has perpetrated an atrocity at sea, 2,000 miles away from Iran’s shores,” Araghchi said. The sinking has triggered a strong reaction within Iran’s political and religious establishment.

CLERIC FOR SHEDDING TRUMP, ISRAELI BLOOD

Atayollah Abdollah Javadi Amoli, a senior cleric, called for retaliation during a televised address. He called for the “shedding of Zionist blood, the shedding of Trump’s blood”, following the naval attack. “We are now on the verge of a great test and we must be careful to fully preserve this unity, to fully preserve this alliance,” he said, adding, “The Imam of the time says, ‘Fight the oppressive America, his blood is on my shoulders.’”

HO OF IRANIAN KURDISH FORCES IN IRAQ HIT

Iran’s military has said it targeted the headquarters of Iranian Kurdish opposition groups in northern Iraq, according to BBC. The military said it attacked “Kurdish groups opposed to the Islamic revolution in Iraq/Kurdistan with three missiles”. One person was killed and three others were injured in the strikes carried out on Tuesday and Wednesday.

WAR TO COST ISRAEL \$3 BILLION A WEEK

The war with Iran could cost Israel an estimated \$1.94 billion (\$3 billion) per week under current restrictions on economic activities, the Israeli Finance Ministry has warned. “In a letter to the Home Front Command chief, Major General Shai Klapper, Finance Ministry Director General Ilan Rom asked to ease restrictions to allow for a gradual, partial reopening of businesses and workplaces as early as Thursday,” the Times of Israel reported.

## Rubio speaks to ministers

Washington, US Secretary of State Marco Rubio spoke to Italian and Saudi Arabian ministers. Rubio first spoke to Italian Foreign Minister Antonio Tajani, and discussed developments in Iran and across West Asia.

## Over 200 killed in Congo coltan mine collapse

Goma: A mine collapse at a coltan mining site in eastern Congo killed at least 200, local and per Congolese officials, a number disputed by the rebel group that controls the mine. The collapse took place on Tuesday at Rubaya mines, controlled by M23 rebels, as per Ministry of Mines. Fanny Kaj, an official in the M23 rebel group disputing the figure and said the collapse was caused by “bombings” and only 5 people had been killed.

## BLACKOUT HITS CUBA

Havana: A blackout left millions of people without power in Havana and the rest of western Cuba on Wednesday in the latest outage on an island struggling with dwindling oil reserves and a crumbling electric grid. An energy official said it could take over 72 hours to restore operations at one of Cuba’s largest thermoelectric power plants, where a shutdown sparked the outage.
